## SACRAMENTO GUITAR SOCIETY PARTICIPATES IN TEARING WALLS APART

*Northern California Guitar Enthusiasts Unite  
to Celebrate World-class Guitars, Luthiers and Guitar Artists*

(Sacramento, CA; Sept 10, 2018) The **Sacramento Guitar Society** will be participating in a fundraising event called Tearing Walls Apart. This event is hosted by the Sacramento Arts Education Consortium, a new initiative of the Office of the Mayor, SMAC, Friends of SMAC, the Sacramento County Office of Education and all 13 local school districts.

The former Mansion Inn located at 16<sup>th</sup> & H Street in downtown Sacramento has laid abandoned for half a decade, right across the Governor's Mansion. Before the walls are torn down to make way for the future, it will be transformed by local Sacramento students who will breathe new life into it with their art. From visual art installations in the hotel rooms, to live music, dance and theatrical performances at the outdoor festival, to a communal art piece that will be a centerpiece of the new hotel – they invite the Sacramento community to explore the answers to humanity's most pressing questions in a public celebration of the power of art to bridge the divide.

There will be a different artist in each of the 46 Mansion rooms. **Sacramento Guitar Society Student Guitarist** will be performing in **Room 33** of the Mansion Inn.
